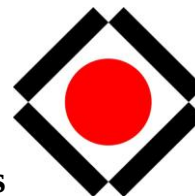




2014 Japan Veterans International Judo Championships



2014 Japan Veterans International Judo Championships *20th and 21st September, KODOKAN, Japan*

1. Technical Information

1.1 Competition:

This event is approved by IJF, hosted by the All Japan Judo Federation

1.2 Date:

20th and 21st September 2014

1.3 Venue:

KODOKAN

1-16-30, Kasuga, Bunkyo-Ku, Tokyo, 112-003, Japan

1.4 Participation

All the following conditions must be met in full for an individual to be considered eligible to participate in this competition.

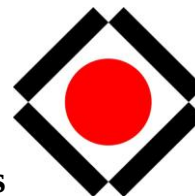
- (1) Competitors must be minimum age of 30 years by year of birth, born 1984 or before.
- (2) Hold a valid license (membership) issued by a National Federation currently affiliated to the IJF.
- (3) If arrange accommodation reservation through Organizer's Travel Agency, payment of accommodation fees should be done by bank transfer before the deadline.
- (4) Pay the appropriate entry fees by cash at the registration.
- (5) Check-in properly at Registration (see schedule for dates and times)
- (6) Meet the specific weight-in requirement as applicable.
- (7) Provide photographic proof of identity using valid and current passport or National ID Card.
- (8) Hold minimum 1st kyu.
- (9) A competitor must not have represented a National Team in a competition at international senior level at any time in the twelve month period before the start date of this particular Japan Veteran International Judo Championships i.e. between 20th September 2013 and 19th September 2014.
- (10) Saw Back Number on Judo-gi (Jacket).

1.5. Proof of identity

Proof of identity, will be established by production of a passport or a National ID Card from the country for which the competitor has been entered. If a competitor has more than one nationality, such competitor can only represent one country and thereafter may not represent any other country, until after a period of one (1) year has elapsed. If the two federations concerned desire, they can ask the IJF to reduce or even to suppress this delay in conformity with the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF.

1.6 Insurance

Participants themselves, competitors and team officials, must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities (third party cover). They must have insurance either held personally in the form of specific insurance cover or travel cover (that does not exclude participating in judo competition) or as part of their National Federation insurance arrangements. Neither the IJF nor Organizer (All Japan Judo Federation) shall be liable for any claims of loss, illness, injury or death.



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It is recommended that all competitors should have had a recent medical check prior to participating in this championships.

Weight Category

Female: -48 kg; -52 kg; -57 kg; -63 kg; -70 kg; -78 kg; +78 kg

Male: -60 kg; -66 kg; -73 kg; -81 kg; -90 kg; -100 kg; +100 kg

The Organizers can combine a category with the next category if the number of participants in a category is not sufficient.

(1) The competition will be carried out according to IJF Referee Rule

(2) Winner for Individual match.

The winner will be decided the score more than Yuko or 1 Shido difference.

(3) No Golden Score

If at the end of the contest there is no difference between two competitors, winner of the match is decided by flag decision (There is no Golden Score for all age divisions).

(4) There will be no Individual open category match.

1.7.2 Team competition – Male

Male: Team consists of 5 competitors with open weight category.

The detail of team member is as follow,

From Age 30 – 39 : 1 player

From Age 40 – 49 : 1 player

From Age 50 – 59 : 1 player

From Age 60 – 69 : 1 player

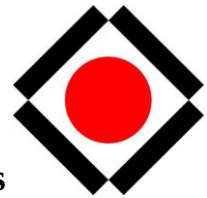
From Age 70 over : 1 player

(1) Competitors from an older age division may compete on a team at one younger age division.

For example, if there is no Age 40 -49 division player, Age 50-59 can be replacement.

(2) The order of team event is in order of age.

(3) If there is no competitor from 70's age category, there is no replacement (the result is lost by no competitor).



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(4) The contest duration is 2.5 minutes for all Male's category, except Age 70 over is 2 minutes.

(5) Winner for each match of team tournament.

The winner will be decided the score more than Yuko or 2 Shido differences.

- Criteria of winner between Individual and Team match is difference.
- If at the end of the contest there is no difference between two competitors, the match will be draw. (No Golden Score System)

(6) Winner as team match

The winner of team match will be decided by the number of contests won. If there is no difference between two teams, the winner will be decided the numbers of Ippon.

If there is still no difference, the winner will be decided the numbers of Waza Ari.

If there is still no difference, the winner will be decided the numbers of Yuko.

If there is still no difference, each select representative player for representative match.

Representative match is 2 minutes (not Golden Score System, even player get Yuko, the match will be continued until Ippon)

1.7.3 Team competition – Female

Female: Team consists of 3 competitors.

Open team event (no age limit, no weight limit).

(1) The contest duration is 2.5 minutes for all Female's category.

(2) The order of team event is in order of age.

1.7.4 Kata competition

(1) The contest will be hold with 7 Kata as follow.

Nage no Kata/ Katame no Kata/ Kime no Kata / Ju no Kata/ Kodokan Goshinjutsu/
Itsutsu no Kata/ Koshiki no Kata

(2) Competitors can apply maximum 2 differences Kata. (But no same Kata can apply)

(3) Paris can be composed of either 2 males, 2 females or a male and a female.

(4) The organizer will provide weapons of Kime no Kata and Kodokan Goshinjutsu.

(5) 5 judges will award points and the Maximum score and Minimum score of each technique will be cancelled. Total of rest of 3 judges score will be the score for the technique. The Total score of each technique will be the final score.

1.8 Weight-in

1.8.1 Individual

(1) The weigh-in takes place on the day before the competition for the categories concerned.

Weight-in: September 19th (Fri) 17:00 – 20:00 at Kodokan

* All competitors for individual must take this weight-in.

There is no weight-in in the morning of the competition.

(2) Each competitor will bring to the weigh-in his or her accreditation card issued at Registration.

(3) Competitors presenting themselves after the closing of the weigh-in, cannot participate in competition.

1.8.2 Team Event

There is no weigh-in for team event, since there is only age category (no weight category).

1.9 Judo-gi

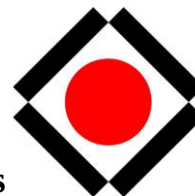
White Judogi only.

The size of Judo-gi must conform to the current regulation. Judo-gi control will be conducted by Judo-gi Sokuteiki.

Back Number

Player must sew Back number.

Back number should be IJF official back number or own back number which mention name and



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country (size should be 30cm – 35cm X 25cm – 30 cm)

1.10 Particular rules for Female competitors.

The Female competitor must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. The bra must not have any hard pieces. Long hair has to be bound with an elastic band. Make-up and jewel are prohibited. The nails have to be cut short.

1.11 Anti doping control

The Organizer has strong anti doping policy, but there will be no anti-doping control at this Championships.

1.12 Entry fees

National Federation or competitors themselves will have to pay entry fees by cash at registration on the spot.

The Entry fee is as follow.

Individual and Team---6,000 yen per person.

Kata--- 1 kata 4,000 yen / 2 kata 6,000 yen

1.13 Hotel Arrangement

Participants can arrange accommodation by themselves. If they want organizer travel agency for the accommodation, they must pay through bank transfer by the deadline. Without payment, all reservation will not be confirmed.

1.14 Entry and Registration information

Please use the appropriate forms in annex Application Form.

Entries for individuals and teams should be submitted by the National Federation. However, in the case of any difficulty in arrangements entries will be accepted through clubs or even individuals.

All players are also required to go to the Registration room to confirm their arrival and deal with the essential administrative issues – payments, weight-in cards, information, sign Waiver of responsibility forms, Team entry forms, Accreditation etc.

1.15 Championships schedule

(1) Please see annex “PROGRAM”.

Note – All medalists must wear full white judogi when taking part in a medal ceremony and not track suit tops etc.

(2) Flags of nations may NOT be held on the rostrum but please be aware that with a large number of ceremony each separate ceremony can only last for a short time to avoids delays to the overall event.

(3) All participants should be available to compete at least 45 minutes before the estimated programmed start times.

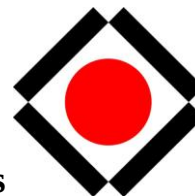
2. Visa

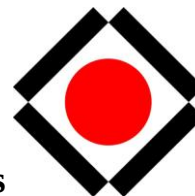
